STATE FAIRGROUNDS REGULATIONS:

All Horses must be kept in stalls. Working out of your trailer is not accepted.

Wood shavings will be used for bedding according to the Iowa State Fairground rules. Shavings will be available for purchase from 9 a.m. until noon on Saturday. Price per bag will be \$6.00

Do not clean your stalls. Stalls will be cleaned by State Fairgrounds personnel.

All performance classes are open to Arabians, Half-Arabians, and Anglo Arabians only - UNLESS specified by ANY BREED noted in the class listing.

Decisions made in the ring will be the Judge's decision.

High Point Classes are marked with X.

Show clothes are not required. Long or short sleeve shirts, long pants, and boots **Are Required.**

Certified Helmet use is strongly encouraged. Users and non-users will be judged equally.

Present yourself and your horse well with appropriate attire.

Not responsible for accidents or theft.

No alcoholic beverages on grounds.

Any Breed: Open to Purebred Arabians, Half Arabians and Other Breeds.

Open Classes: Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings

Novice Classes: Open to those who have not won three First Place ribbons in that division.

Horizon Classes: Open to non-professional, inexperienced riders or handlers starting to show or returning after several years.

Horizon Eligibility: Horizon exhibitors may compete in that division until winning the High Point end of year CHAMPIONSHIP.

Optional Equipment: Exhibitors may show in Western, English, or Hunt equipment. (Does not mean training equipment).

Ring Issues: The Judge has final call.

Show Manager may add or delete classes the day of the show.
